We think you may have noticed an increase of people outdoors, walking, running and cycling; we in patrol definitely have seen it. As a reminder bicycles are not allowed to be on the sidewalks. We have had several incidents that were reported where bicycle riders have had near collisions with people on the sidewalk.

In addition, please remember that Eagle's Nest golf course is closed to all traffic; foot traffic, golf carts, scooters, bicycles, roller skates, skateboards, Segways...we think you get the idea.. The course is a construction zone, and trespassers will be cited.
