

Chelsea Points System

The Chelsea Reservation System uses a weighted lottery to determine tee times. Team points are calculated based on the member's points. Each member's 14-day moving average is added to the team total. The team total is divided by the number of player's to obtain an average for the team. The average is used in ranking the teams. A guest assumes the points of the sponsoring member and is counted in the team's average.

Example:

<u>Player</u>	<u>Net Points</u>
Captain	2
Player 2	1
Player 3	3
Player 4	<u>4</u>
Total	10
Number of Players	<u>4</u>
Team Average	2.5

Teams are placed by lowest average receiving priority. Ties are broken randomly by the computer.

How are points assessed?

Homeowners

- ½ point for placement on the tee sheet
- 1 point at the End of Day for playing
- 1 point at the End of Day for playing prime time

Annual Members

- ½ point for placement on the tee sheet
- ½ point at the End of Day for playing
- ½ point at the End of Day for playing in prime time

Annual Plus Members

- ½ point for placement on tee sheet
- ¼ point at the End of Day for playing
- ¼ point at the End of Day for playing in prime time

On Golf Association Days and special events all players are only assessed 1 point for playing (No placement points or prime time points are assessed).

The placement point is assessed when the member is placed on the tee sheet 5 days out. This point cannot be cancelled once placement is made. The play point and prime time point occur at the end of the day. If a player is taken off the sheet, or doesn't play in prime time, these points are not assessed. Tee sheets are processed daily.

Prime time varies by the time of the year and is based upon 18 hole completion time. In the winter season, prime time ends at 1:30 p.m. In the summer season, prime time ends at 3 p.m.

- If a player cancels and we fill his spot, the player still receives the placement point. The substituted player will receive the play points and prime time points.

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
