As numbers continue to rise for reported positive cases of COVID-19 all over the country, in Arizona, and indeed right here in PebbleCreek, once again the HOA reminds you to remain vigilant where safe conduct is concerned. There have been a number of recent positive COVID-19 cases throughout the PebbleCreek community. While we have been dealing with this for many months now, elapsed time is not a measure that allows us to let down our guard. Everyone should take personal responsibility for their own actions, health and safety. Following the steps below will not only protect you—but will protect those around you and help to slow and stop the spread of the virus.

- Wear a well-fitting mask.
 - It will not only protect those around you, but per CDC guidance, masks also afford some measure of protection for the wearer as well.
 - Be sure the mask has a snug fit and covers both your mouth and nose at all times

- Keep at least six feet of distance between you and others who are not part of your immediate household, if you have to be around people.
 - The safest course of action is to avoid unnecessary contact and only go out to do essential activities, like getting groceries, necessary doctor visits, etc., but if you must be around others, exercise social distance and limit the length of time to less than 15 minutes.
 - While the HOA cannot enforce this behavior, we strongly encourage it

- Wash your hands regularly with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, making sure to create friction as you wash.

As you engage in everyday activities, you are advised to assume anyone you may come into contact with is positive for the virus. Doing so will, hopefully, result in everyone following the safety guidelines as recommended, and is in the best interest of you, your friends and neighbors, and the community. You are strongly encouraged to stay home, not gather, and to minimize interactions to only essential activities. Please, take responsible action today.
