

Coronavirus community update – Basketball court to join other outdoor recreation facilities in reopening

Previously, it was announced that Bocce, Pickleball, and Tennis would reopen with strict protocols.

The basketball court located at Eagle’s Nest will now join these facilities in reopening on Friday, May 8, also with strict protocols. The softball field will reopen on May 11, giving homeowners five outdoor venues to enjoy.

The previous announcement regarding outdoor recreational facilities is copied below:

Last week, Governor Ducey issued a new Executive Order that extends the original Stay-at- Home Order until May 15, with some modifications. The latest order promotes engaging in outdoor exercise activity, but only if appropriate physical distancing is used (at least six feet from any other person consistent with CDC guidelines). As we shared recently, the management team has been working on a strategic plan for reopening, in phases. We would like to announce today, that we are able to reopen, with strict protocols, activity on the Bocce, Pickleball and Tennis courts beginning Friday, May 8. Softball activity will begin on May 11. We have worked with the club leadership to come up with an opening plan and to be sure they are prepared. HOA management and club leadership have agreed upon rules and protocols for usage of the courts as these outdoor activities resume, with an emphasis on social distancing and regular sanitation. The clubs will help monitor and ensure that all rules and protocols are followed. In addition, the clubs will be handling all reservations through their club reservation systems.

We understand that not everyone will feel comfortable returning to these kinds of activities. For

those who do want to get back out and play, please understand that it is your personal responsibility to follow all the rules, guidelines and protocols. Only you can dictate whether these facilities stay open for play; failure to comply with these guidelines could result in the closure of the facility. Your behavior will determine how we move forward. Following guidelines and rules, especially related to social distance, are an absolute must. Until further notice, only PebbleCreek residents are allowed to use the sports courts. No guests are permitted.
