Coronavirus prompts extended State and Federal Income Tax deadlines

Arizona Governor Doug Ducey issued an administrative action aimed at providing relief to taxpayers affected by COVID-19. The administrative action, issued by the Arizona Department of Revenue (ADOR), extends the deadline for filing and paying state income taxes from April 15 to July 15, 2020. This is consistent with Treasury Secretary Steve Mnuchin's announcement that the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) has moved the deadline for 2019 federal tax returns to July 15, 2020, and individual, corporate and fiduciary tax returns. The new deadline means taxpayers filing state and/or federal tax returns or submitting payments after the previous April 15 deadline will not be assessed late payment penalties or interest.
